

Install filter

Turn off air purifier and pull power cord out of the socket before installing filter.

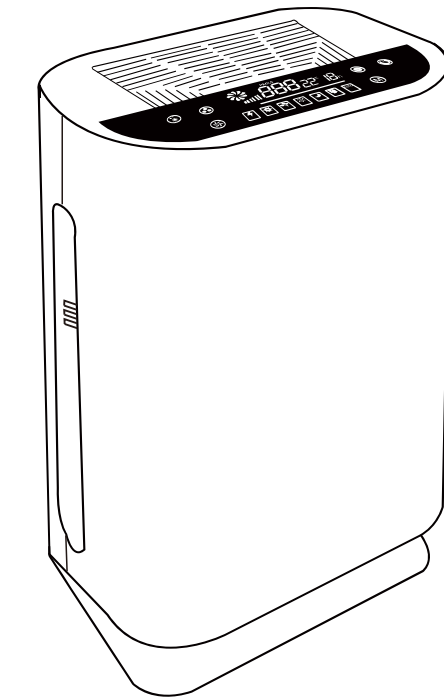
1. Take out the front panel
2. Take the filter out from the packaging bag
3. Put front panel back

Trouble shooting

| Issues | Checking |
|---|---|
| Not working | Check if power cord connected well with socket. |
| The air quality indicator is always red | Sensor may be influenced by water vapor, fumes, sprays. Test air purifier in another clean environment. |
| Abnormal smell | Check if filter is out of effect or there are absorb pollutants releasing smells. Clean the filter according to our instructions on Page 1. |
| Abnormal sound | Make sure that package of filter has been removed. |
| | Make sure that there isn't any substance nearby inlet or outlet. |
| Working louder | Check if filter is out of effect. Clean the filter according to our instructions on Page 1. |

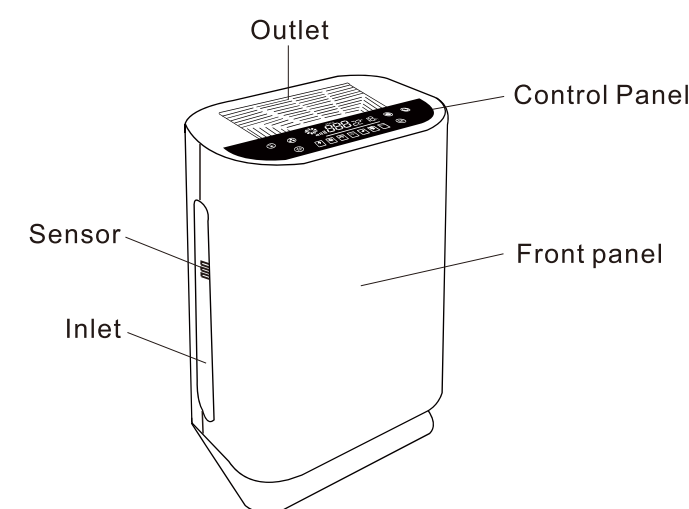

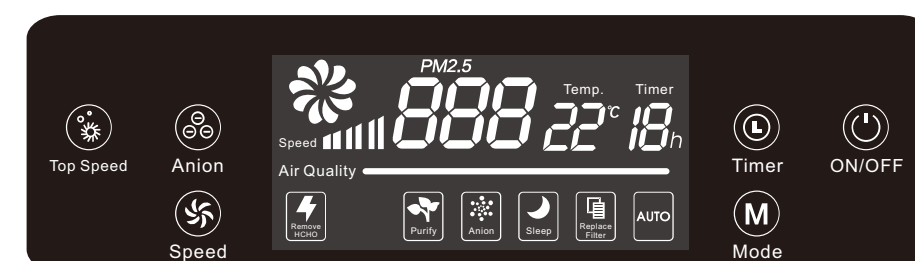

Details



Control Panel



ON/OFF

The icon flashes after plugging power cord into socket. The default mode is "Top Speed" mode after air purifier turns on.

Timer

To set a shutdown timer: 1-12H

Mode

To switch work mode: Auto-Sleep-Manual
Auto mode: Fan speed varies depending on air quality.
Sleep mode: The light of display screen turns off except "Sleep".

Speed

Fan speed setting: 1-2-3

Anion

To turn on/off anion function.

Replace filter

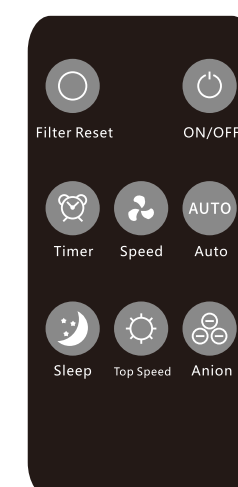
The air purifier calculates the filter lifetime according to the running status. The indicator light is on when filter needs replacing. After the old filter has been replaced with new one, press "filter reset" button on remote to reset filter lifetime calculation.

Air quality indication

The light flashes after air purifier turns on, which means the sensor is warming up.

Green: Good
Orange: Normal
Red: Poor

Filter upkeep

1. The filter is non-washable.
2. The lifetime will vary depending on the hours of usage, air quality and location of the air purifier. Normally the filter will need to be replaced every 8-12 months.
3. Clean up the dust and contaminants with vacuum cleaner or hair dryer(cool air) after 1-2 months of usage, and dry it out in the sun for 3 hours to maintain the best purifying effect.

Warnings

1. Turn off air purifier and pull out power cord before filter replacing, cleaning and maintaining.
2. Do not clean the body with chemical solvent or strong acid/base cleaning agent.
3. Turn off air purifier and pull out power cord before moving air purifier.
4. Keep the inlet 20cm or more far from the wall or any substances.
5. Check out power cord periodically. If there is any surface damage or deterioration, stop using and contact us to replace it.
6. Do not plug into the socket with unmatched AC power.
7. Do not drag the power cord.
8. Stop the usage when there exist abnormal sound, odor and abnormal heat in air purifier.
9. Do not put finger or foreign substances into inlet or outlet.
10. No heavy substances on the air purifier.
11. Keep air purifier away from dust, moist, rain, heat source, direct sunlight and uneven position.
